The Tudor Choristers was founded in Melbourne in 1962 by David Carolane OAM. It soon expanded to become one of Victoria's pre-eminent choirs, specialising in unaccompanied music. Notable guest conductors have included Sir David Willcocks and Sir Philip Ledger.



With a stellar career spanning three decades in six countries, Melbourne-born **Dr Kathleen McGuire** has directed choral and instrumental ensembles on international stages including Carnegie Hall, the Kennedy Center, and Sydney Opera House. She earned her doctorate in conducting at the University of Colorado, Boulder (USA), Master of Music with Distinction at University of Surrey (UK) as the recipient of a Rotary International Fellowship, Graduate Diploma in Education at Monash University, Graduate Diploma in conducting at the Victorian College of the Arts and BMus in composition at the Melbourne Conservatorium of Music. Kathleen lived in the USA for almost two decades, where "Kathleen McGuire Day" was designated on two occasions by mayors of San Francisco, she was named "Local Hero" by ABC-TV, and The American Prize awarded her work several times in the Professional Composer Division. Kathleen moved back to Australia in 2013. In addition to freelance conducting and composing, she lectures at Australian Catholic University, teaches music at Brunswick Secondary College and directs the Star Chorale. She commenced her tenure with Tudor Choristers in 2017.
